




















What percentage of students feel safe in the hallways, bathrooms, locker rooms, and cafeteria?



What percentage of students say that their teachers support them when they are upset?




What percentage of middle school students say that their school provides them with guidance on the high school application process?




What percentage of families say that their school will make them aware if there are any concerns about their child's social or emotional well-being?\*\*





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





What percentage of teachers say that they trust the principal (to do what they say that they will do)?




What percentage of teachers say that they trust each other?




